

SAE

All proficiency and degree applications must derive from a valid SAE as defined by the Oregon FFA Association SAE Policies (see below) and must fit into one of the National FFA Proficiency Award areas.

A student's SAE is considered appropriate and applicable for a state FFA degree when the teacher and student is able to answer "yes" to question 1 and "yes" to either question 2 or 3.

1. Does the supervised experience involve the application of agriculture content standards and employability skills?

AND

2. Does the supervised experience contribute to the production, processing and/or marketing of an agricultural, horticultural, or natural resource products or the scientific research of an agricultural product or process?

OR

3. Does the supervised experience provide a service for the industries of the AFNR cluster?
